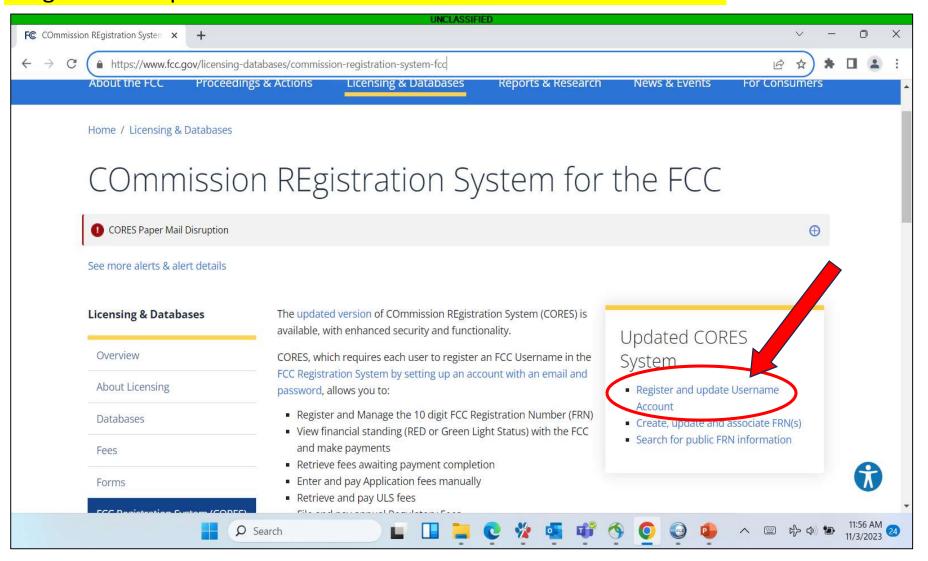
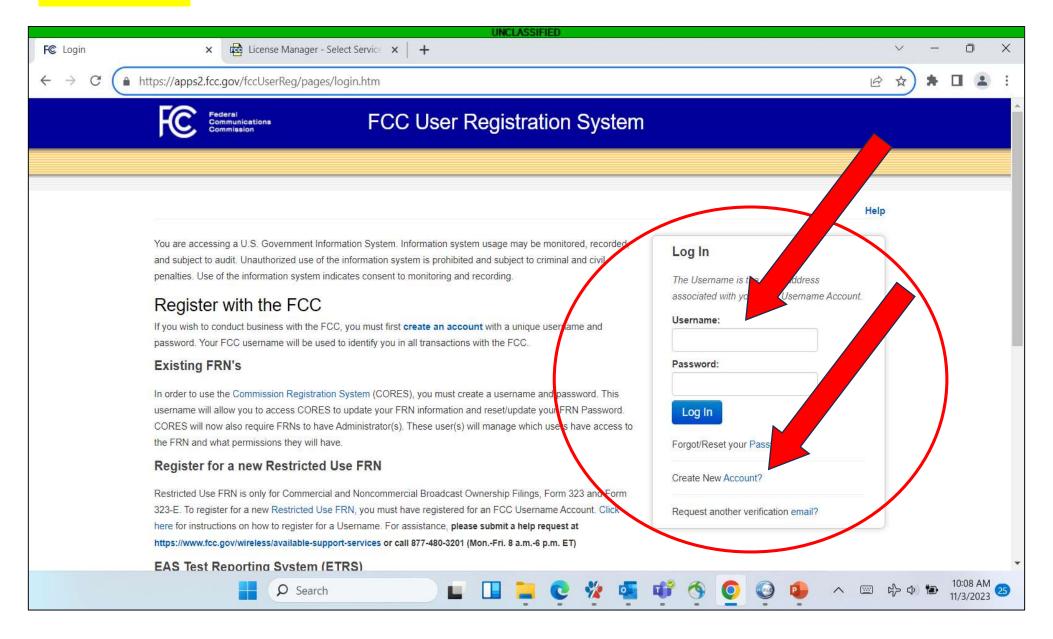
# How to obtain a new FCC Ship Station License

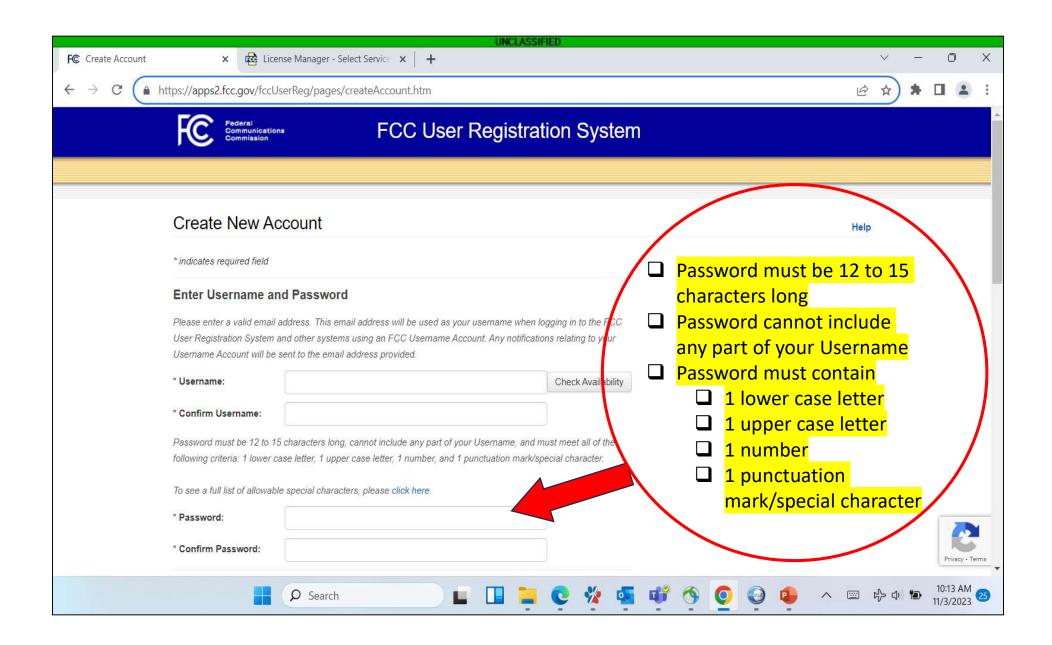
To order an FCC Ship Station License, you will need a username account and an FCC Registration Number (FRN). The starting point for this process is through the FCC CORES page on the web page <a href="https://www.fcc.gov/licensing-databases/commission-registration-system-fcc">https://www.fcc.gov/licensing-databases/commission-registration-system-fcc</a>. To register, update, or create a username account, select the "Register and update Username Account" link shown below in red.



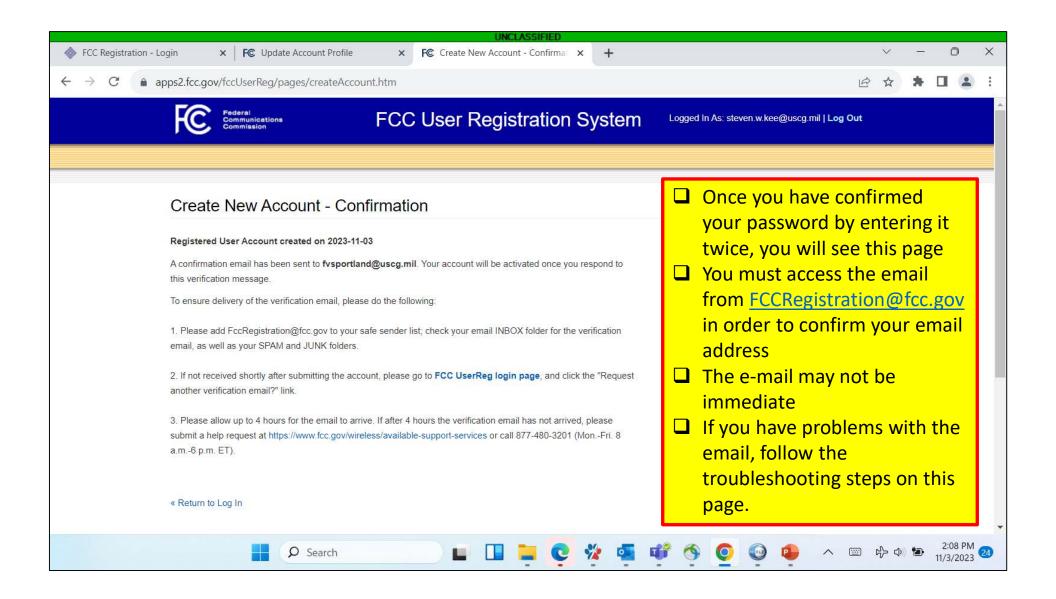
After you select the username link, you will be taken to the page shown below <a href="https://apps2.fcc.gov/fccUserReg/pages/login.htm">https://apps2.fcc.gov/fccUserReg/pages/login.htm</a>. If you have an account, log in with your username and password. If you need to create a username, select the "Create New Account" link.



If you selected to "Create New Account", you will be taken to the screen as shown below. Enter the information to create a new account using your email as the username. An activation email will be sent to continue the process.

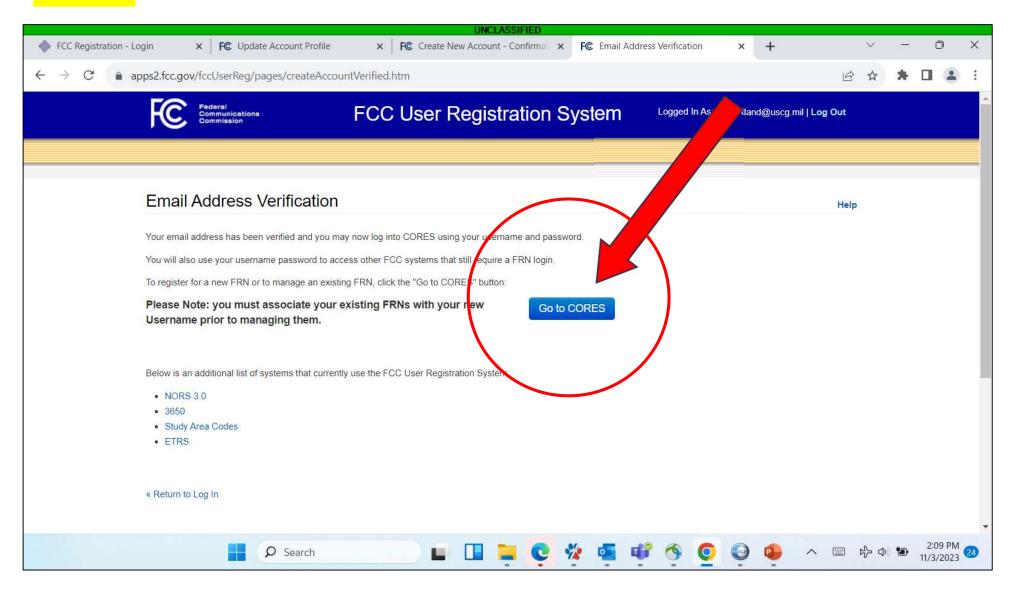


You will see this confirmation page as part of the "new account" process shown on the previous page.

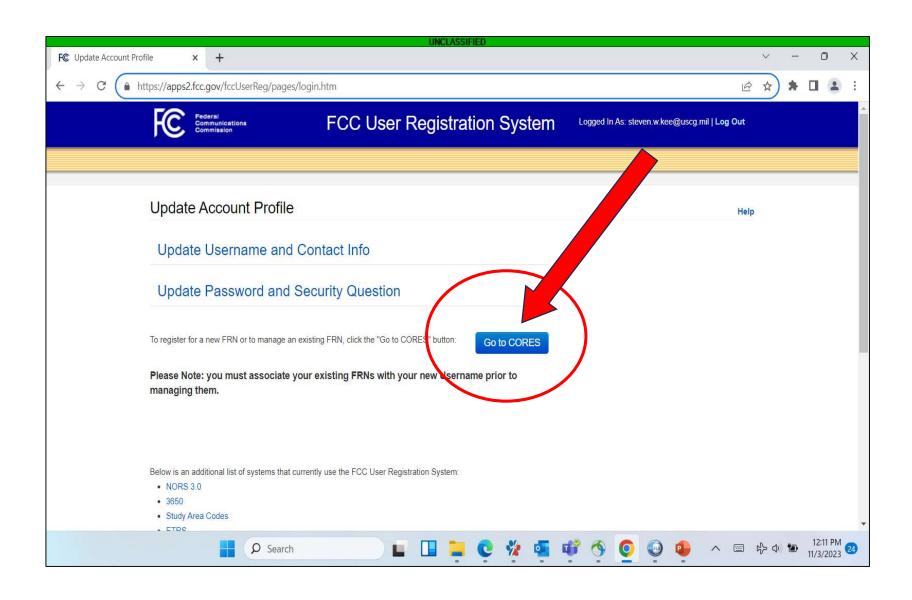


You will receive an email like the one shown below as part of the "new account" process shown on the previous pages.

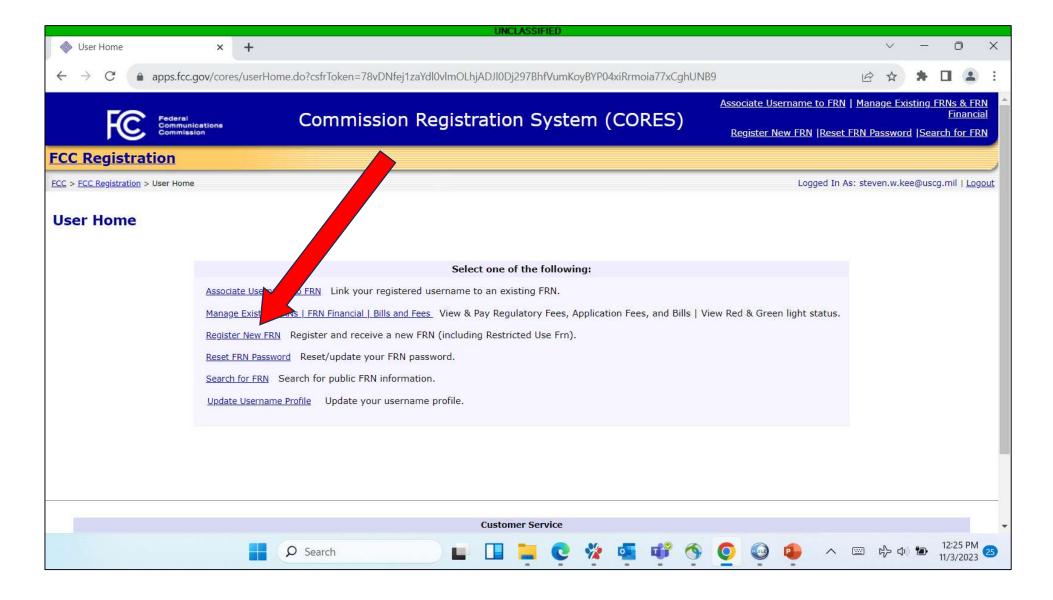

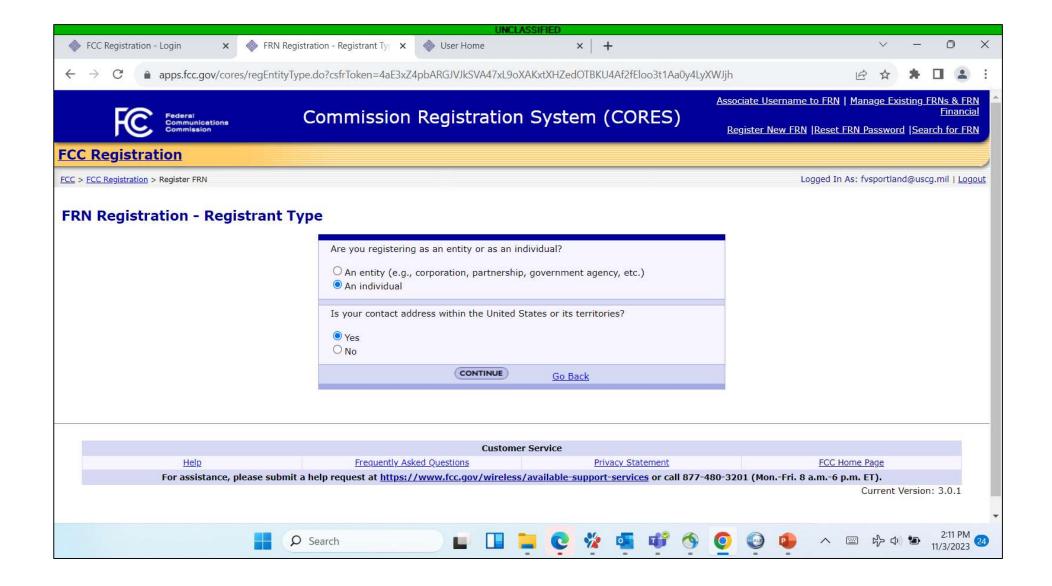

Select "Register New FRN" if you have not previously created one or if you need to create a new one.

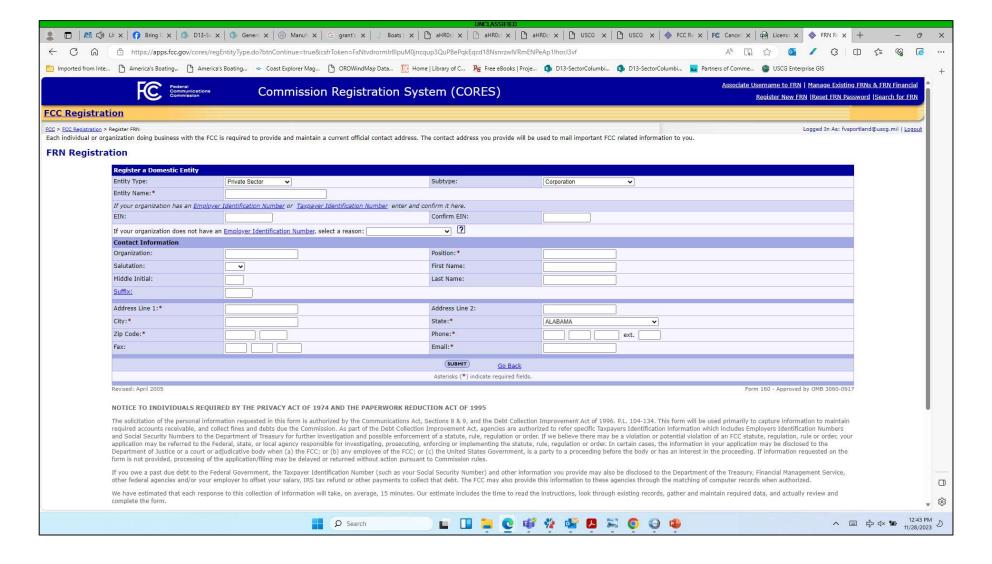


## Select the appropriate choices for your situation.

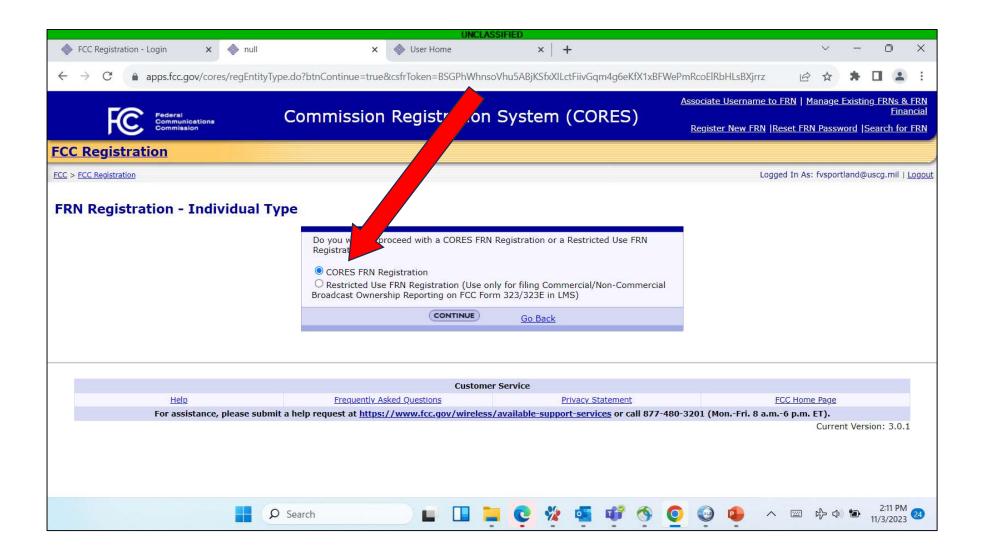


If you selected "An entity" on the previous page, this page will appear. Once you enter the information, you will be assigned a new FRN.

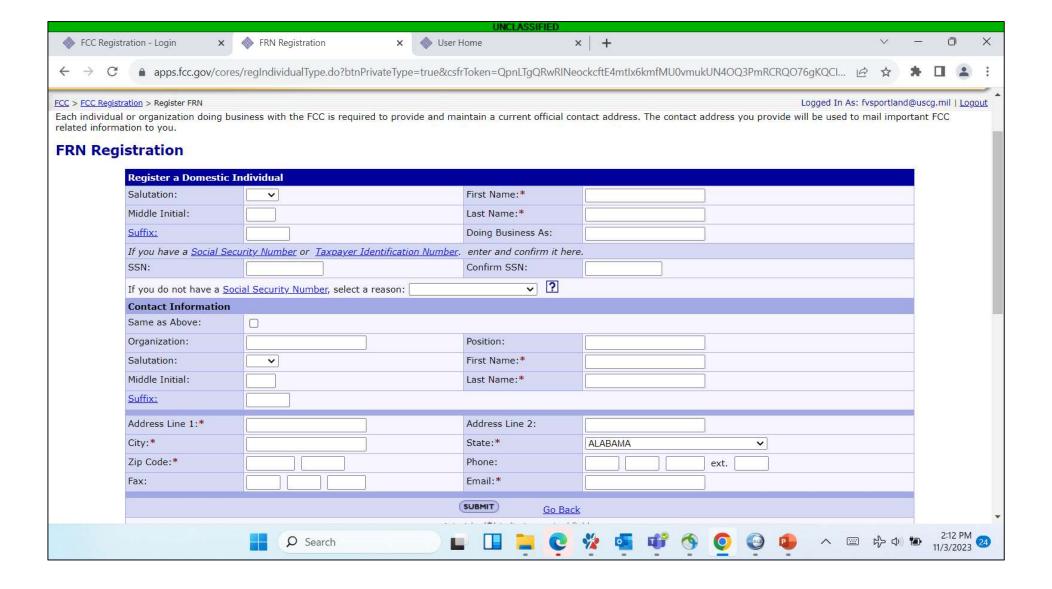

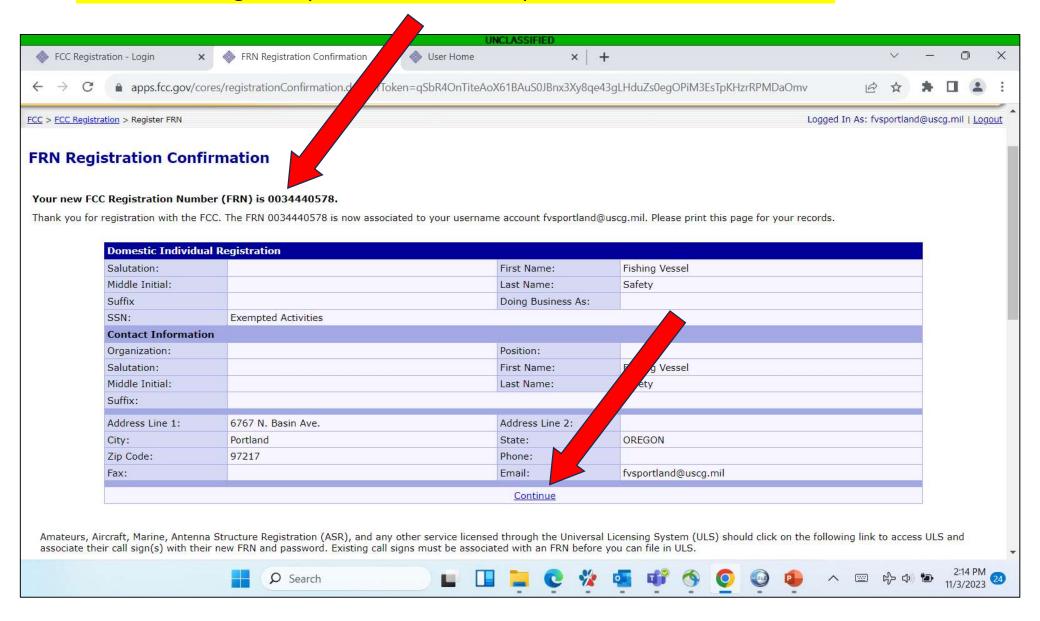
If you selected "Individual", this is the page you will see. Select "CORES FRN Registration" and "Continue".



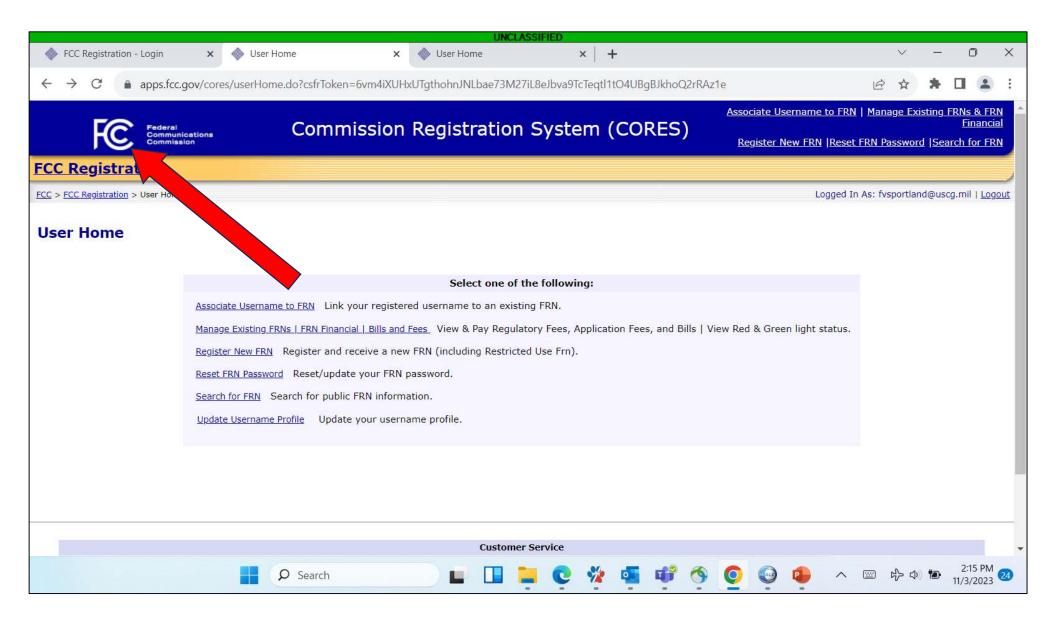
# This page will show up for your FRN Registration. Enter the information and then submit.



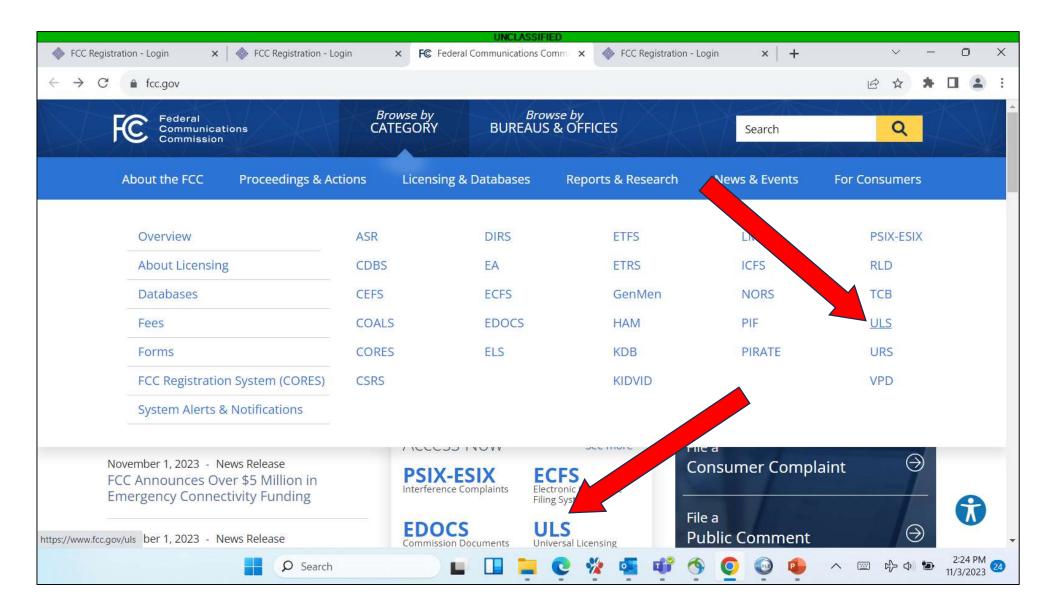
This page is your new "Individual" FRN. Your FRN should be noted for future reference along with your username and password. Select "Continue".



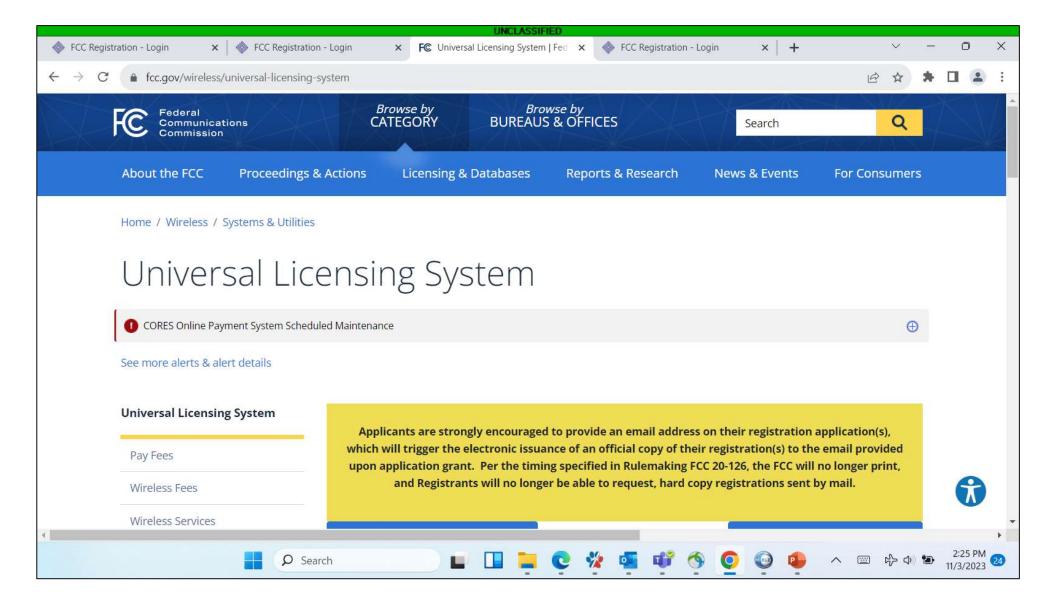
To get to the next step, use the "FCC" hyperlink to get to the <u>www.fcc.gov</u> homepage or type it into your browser.



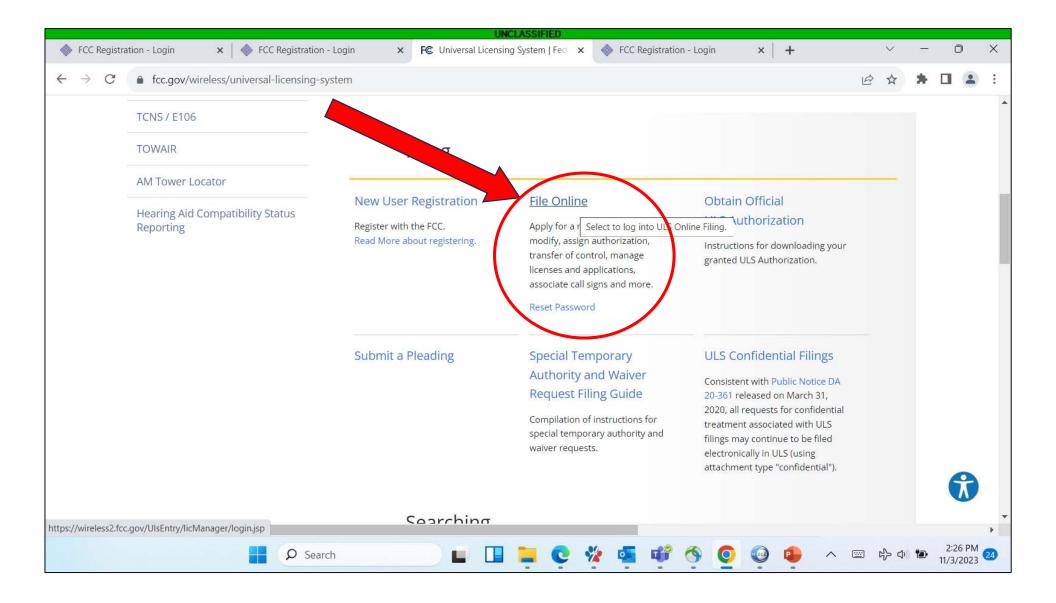
Once you are on the FCC homepage, go to the "Universal Licensing System" by clicking on one of the ULS hyperlinks.



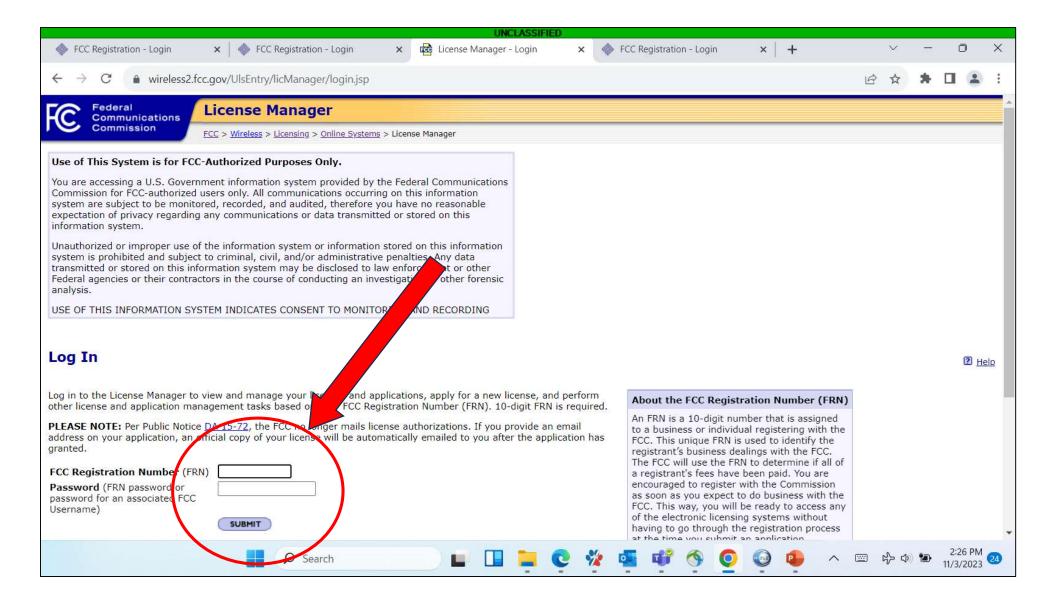
Once you are on the ULS homepage, scroll down and select "File Online". (see next page)



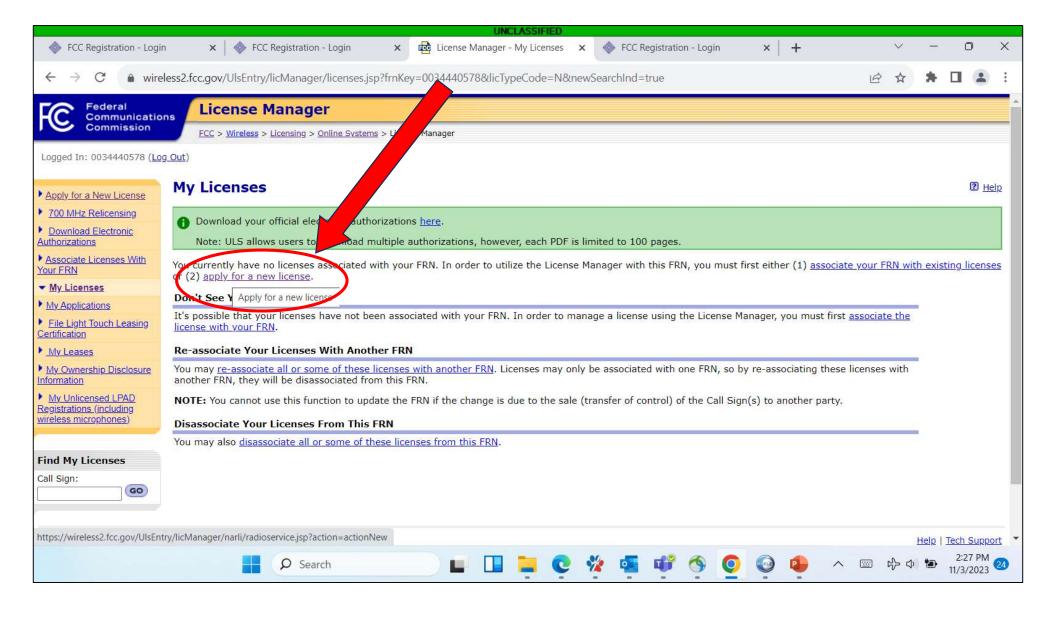
## Click on "File Online" to continue.



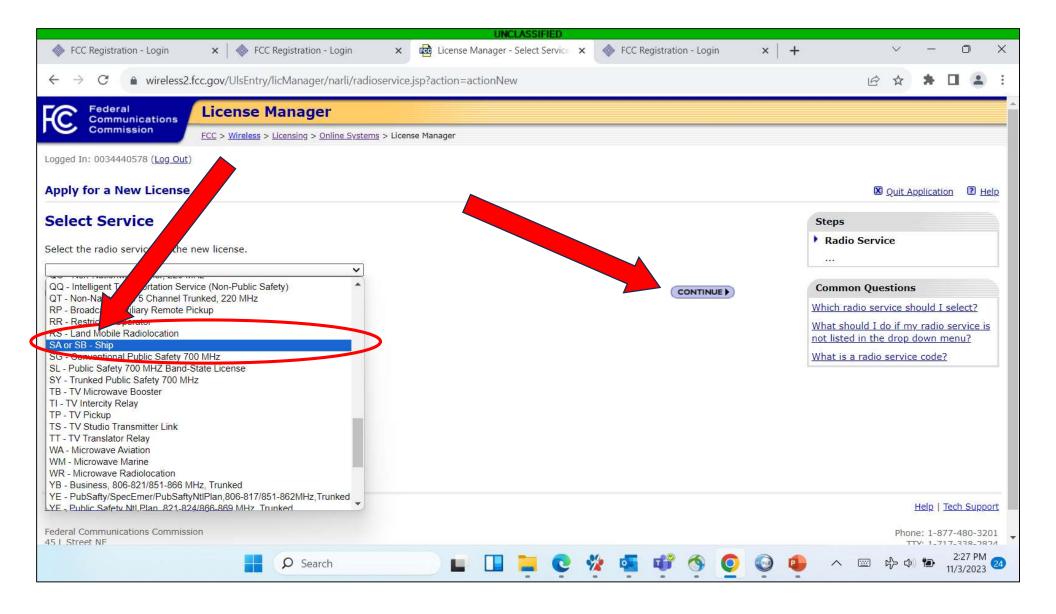
Enter the FRN you were assigned in the previous steps. Enter your username password and select "Submit".



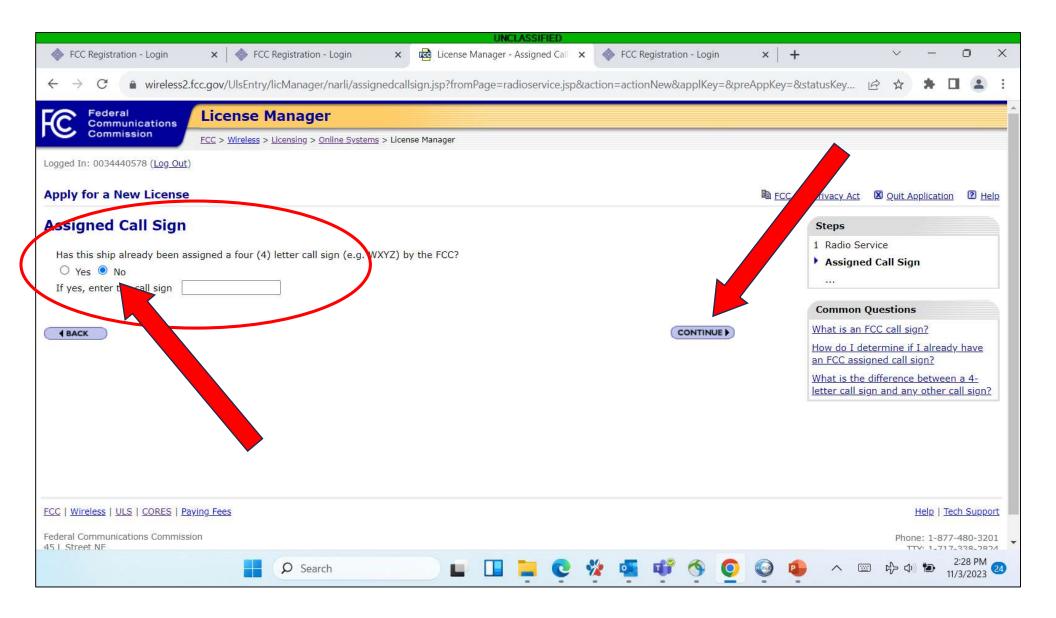
## Select "Apply for a new license."



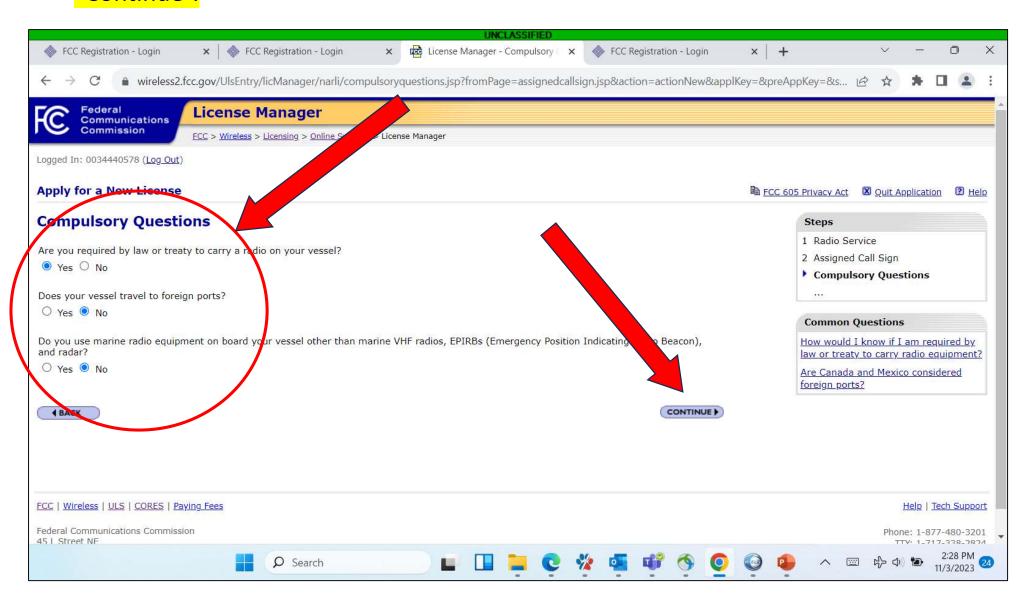
## Choose "SA or SB-Ship" for the service. Then "Continue".



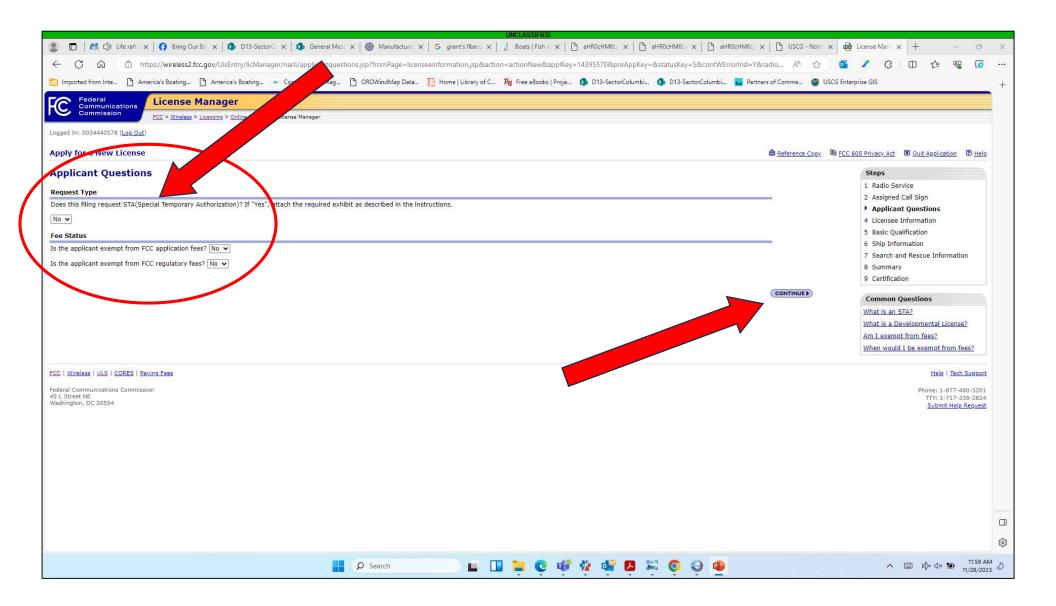
Most people will choose "No". If you do have a 4 letter call sign, select "Yes", enter it, and then "Continue".



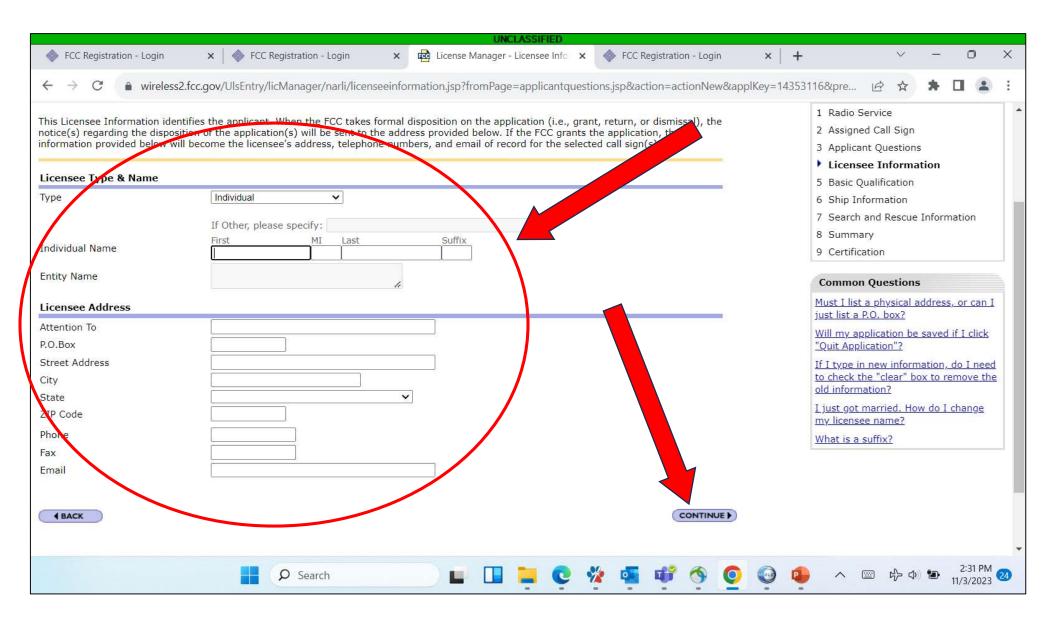
Select "Yes" for the 1<sup>st</sup> question. Most boats will select "No" for the foreign ports and other equipment. Select which is best for your operations. Then select "Continue".



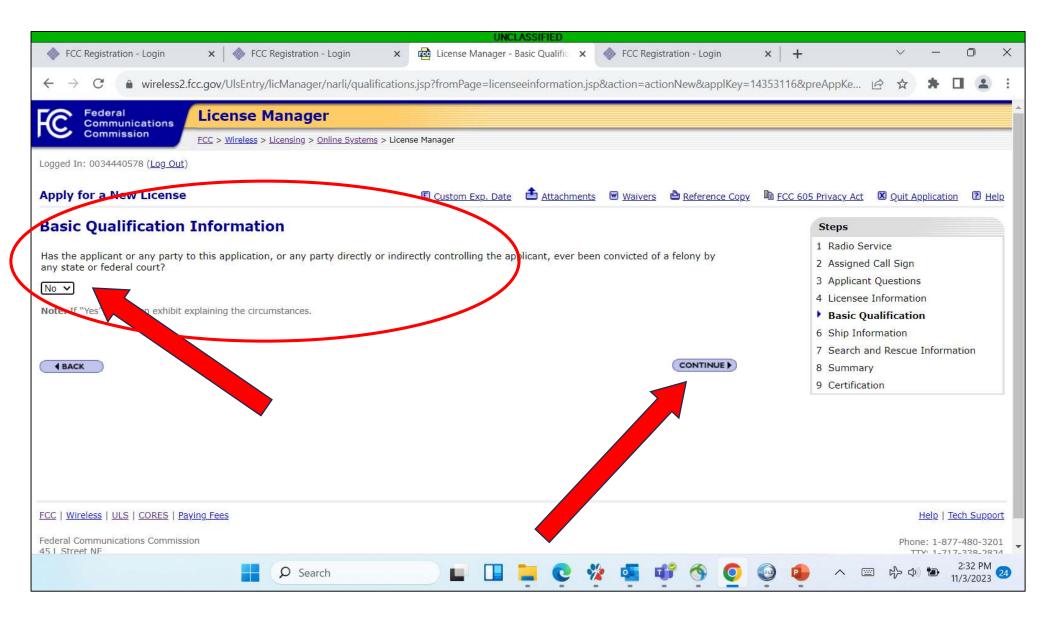
Under "Applicant Questions", select "No" for these 3 questions. Then select "Continue".



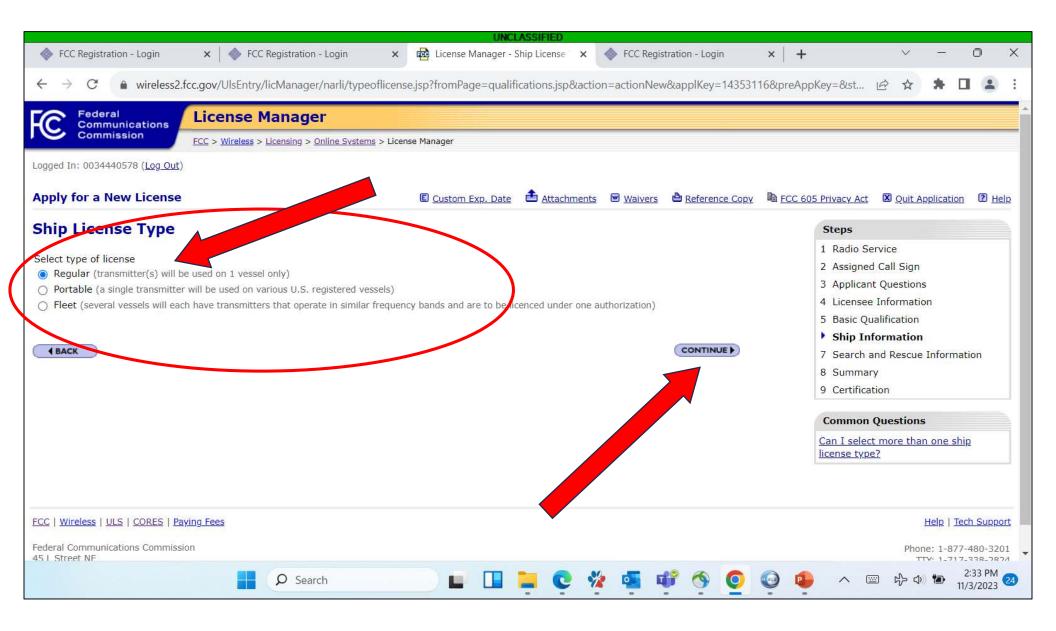
### Select the appropriate license type and enter the details. Then select "Continue".



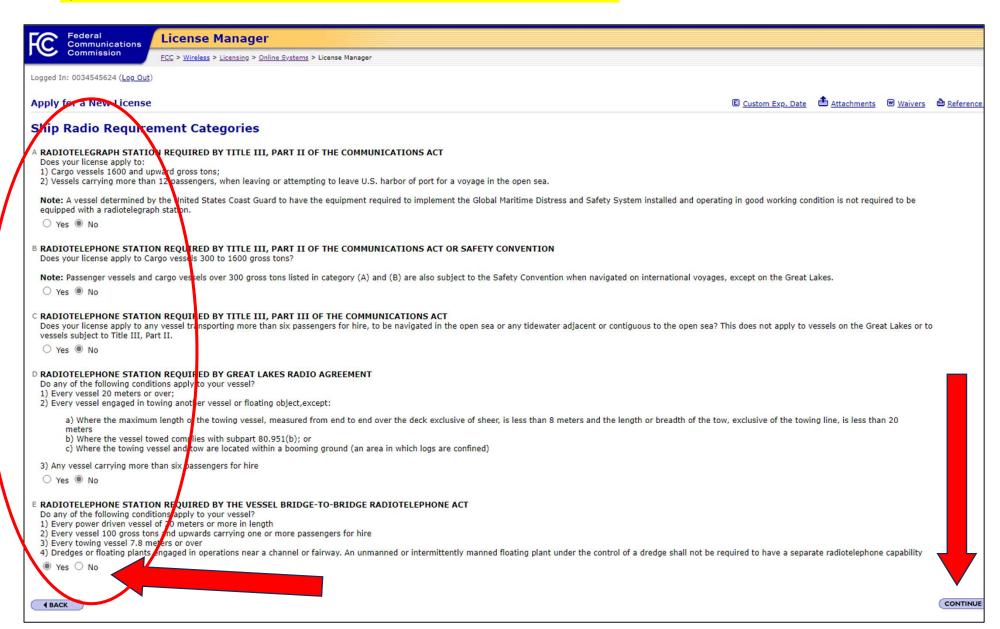
## Select the appropriate response for a felony conviction. Then select "Continue".



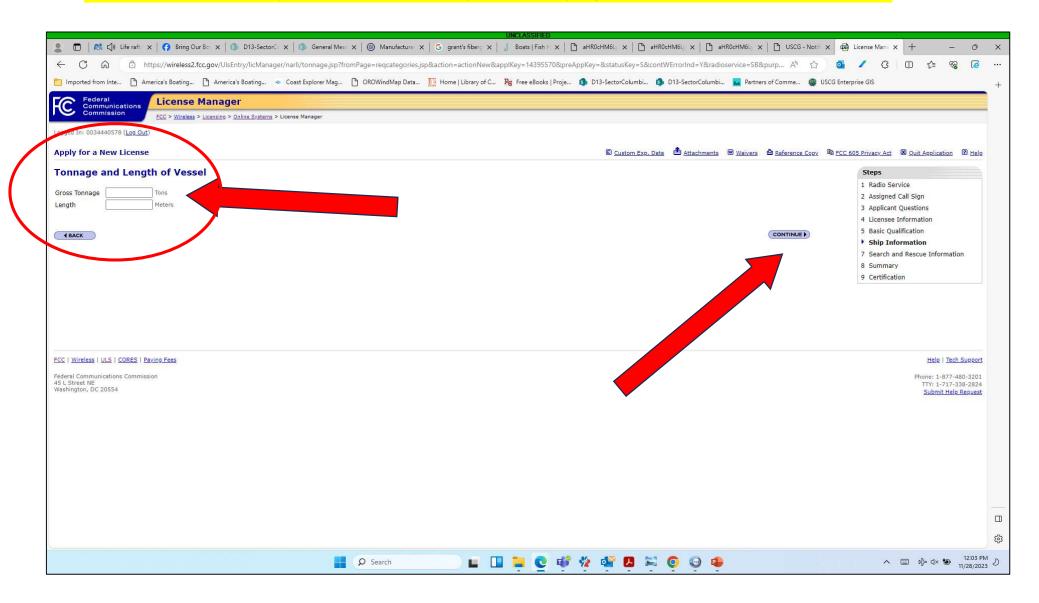
## Select "Regular" for the type of license. Then select "Continue".



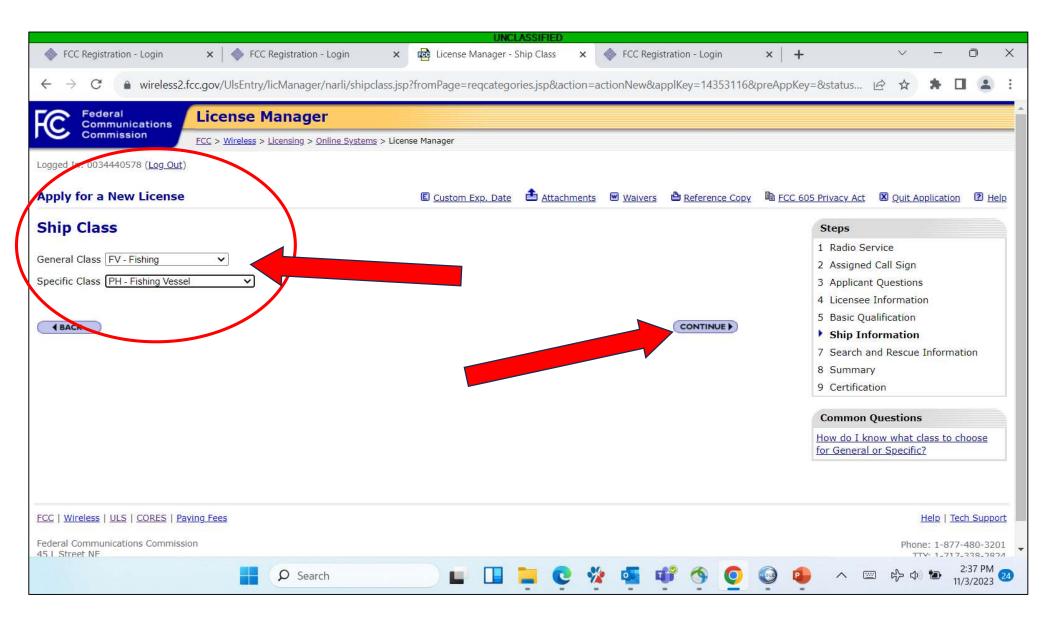
Select "No" for questions A, B, C, and D. Select the appropriate "Yes" or "No" for question E (Yes for >65.6ft). Then select "Continue".



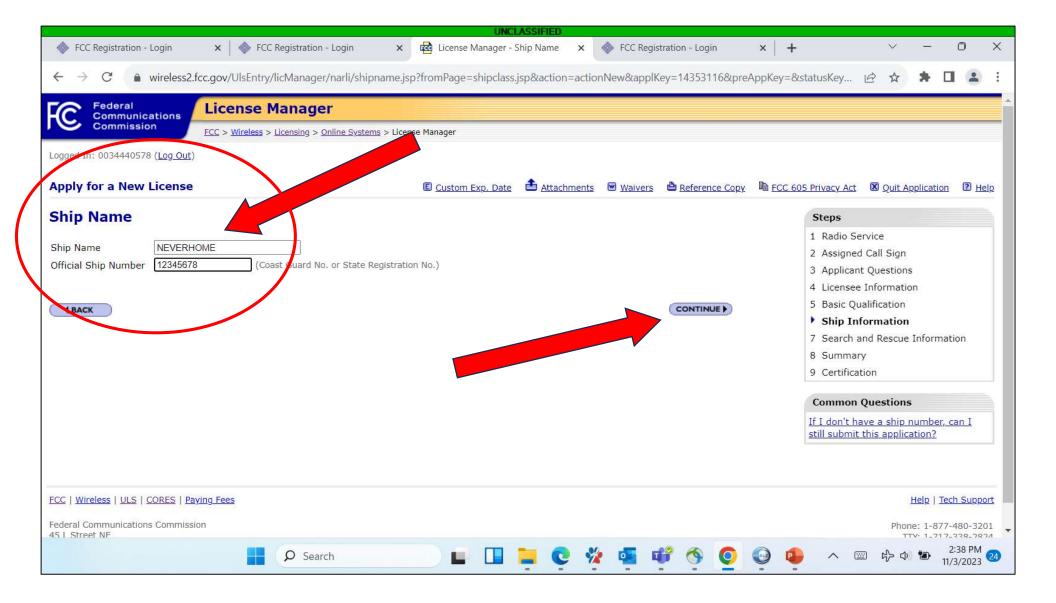
If you answered "Yes" to question E on the previous page, you will be prompted to enter the vessel Gross Tonnage and Length. (This page will not show up if you selected "No" to question E on the previous page). Then select "Continue".



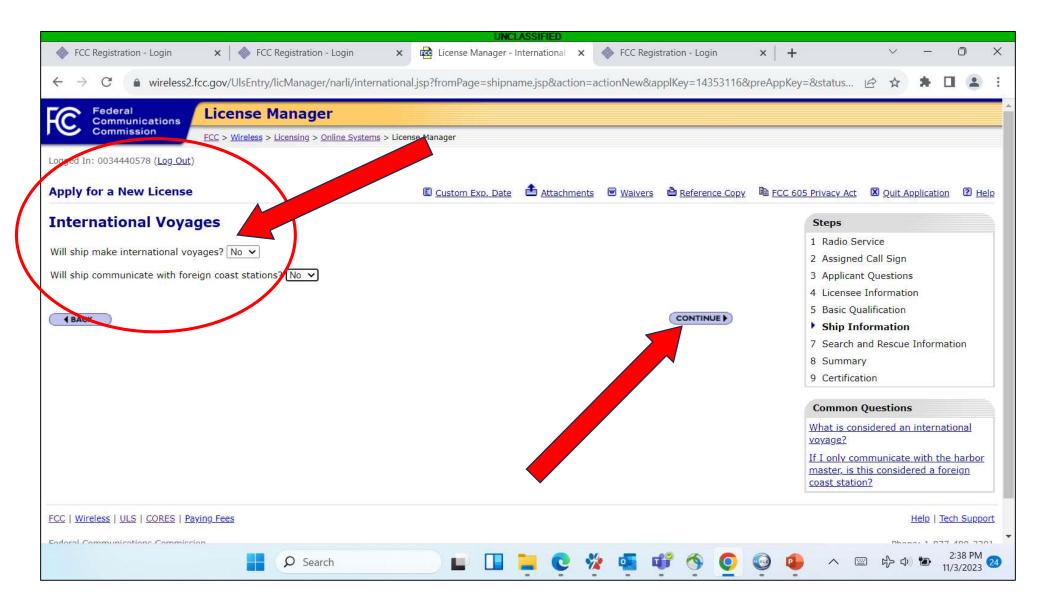
Select "FV-Fishing" for General Class. Select "PH-Fishing Vessel" for Specific Class. Then select "Continue".



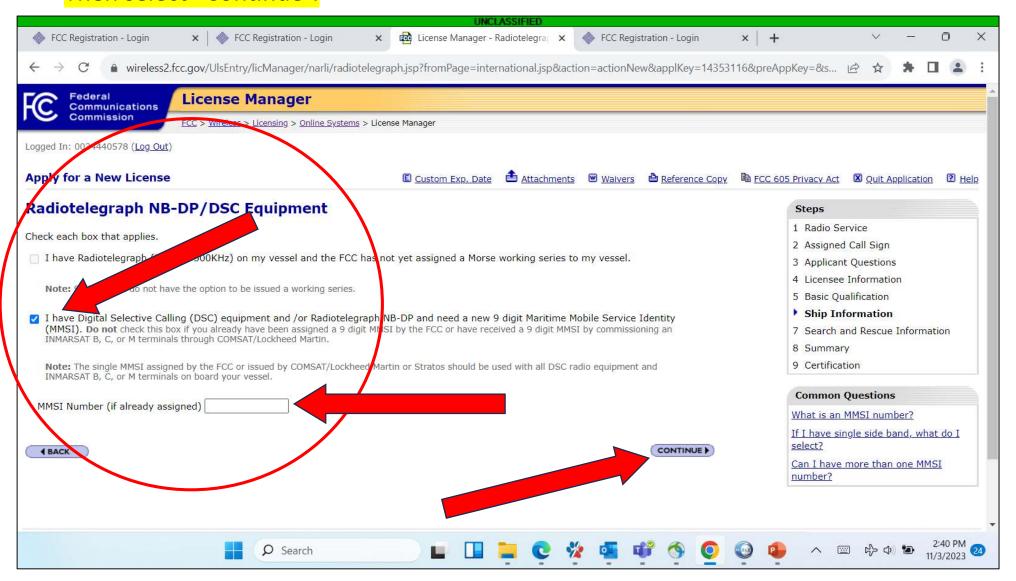
Enter the vessel name and official number (the number found on the Certificate of Documentation). Then select "Continue".



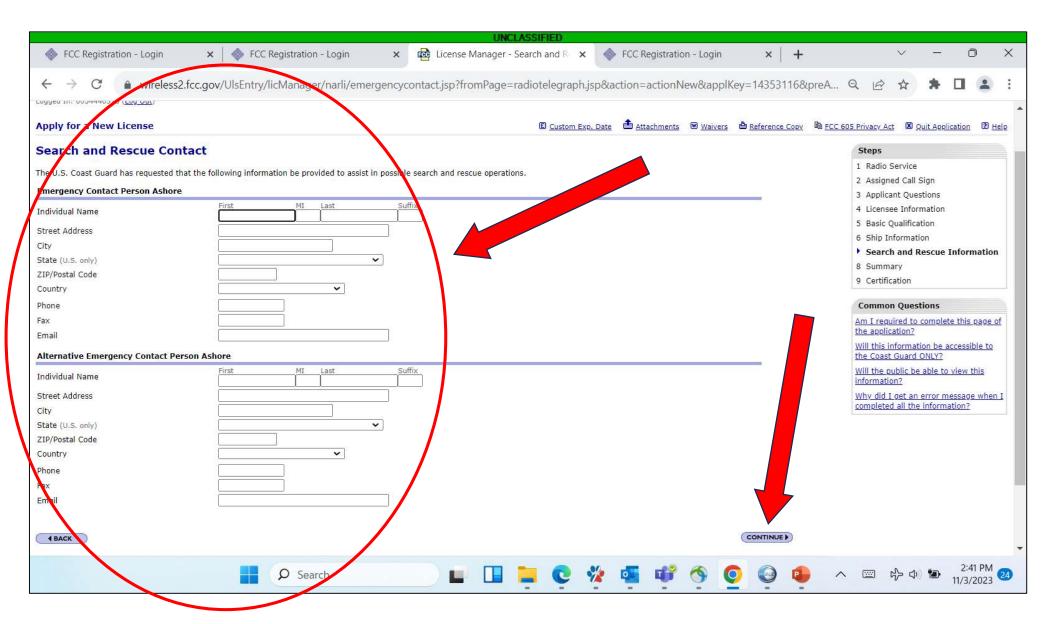
Select the appropriate responses for international voyages. Most vessel will select "No" for both questions. Then select "Continue".



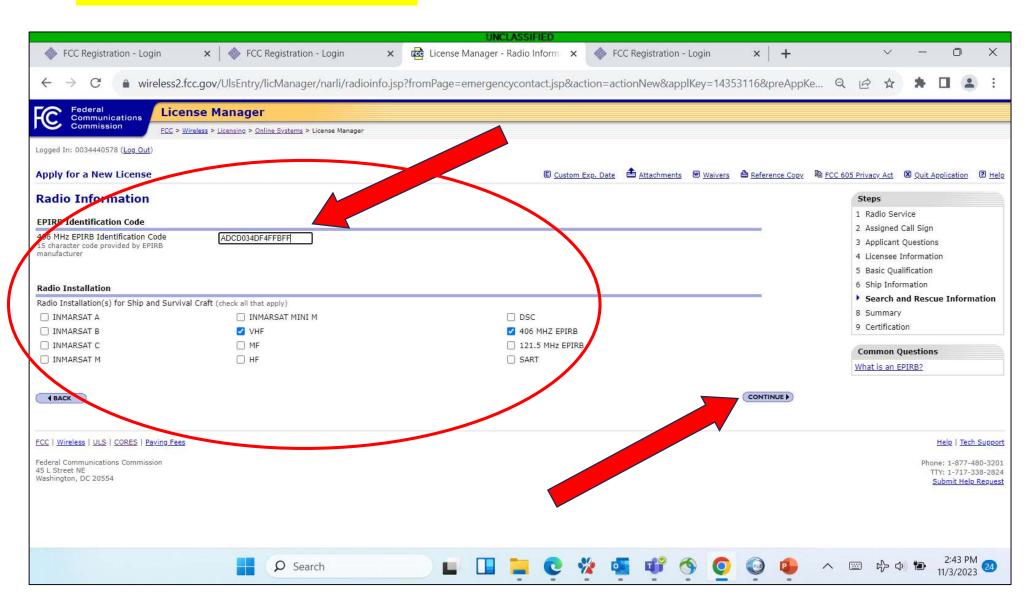
If you need a new Maritime Mobile Service Identity (MMSI), check the box. If you have an existing MMSI, do not check the box, and enter the MMSI in the box. Then select "Continue".



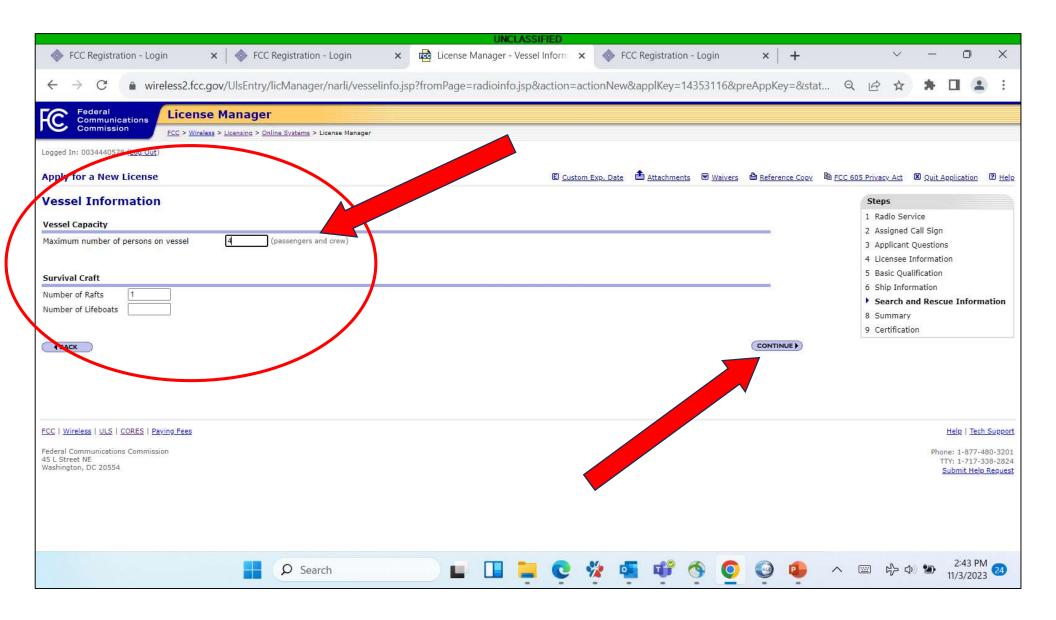
Enter emergency contact information in the appropriate blocks. Then select "Continue".



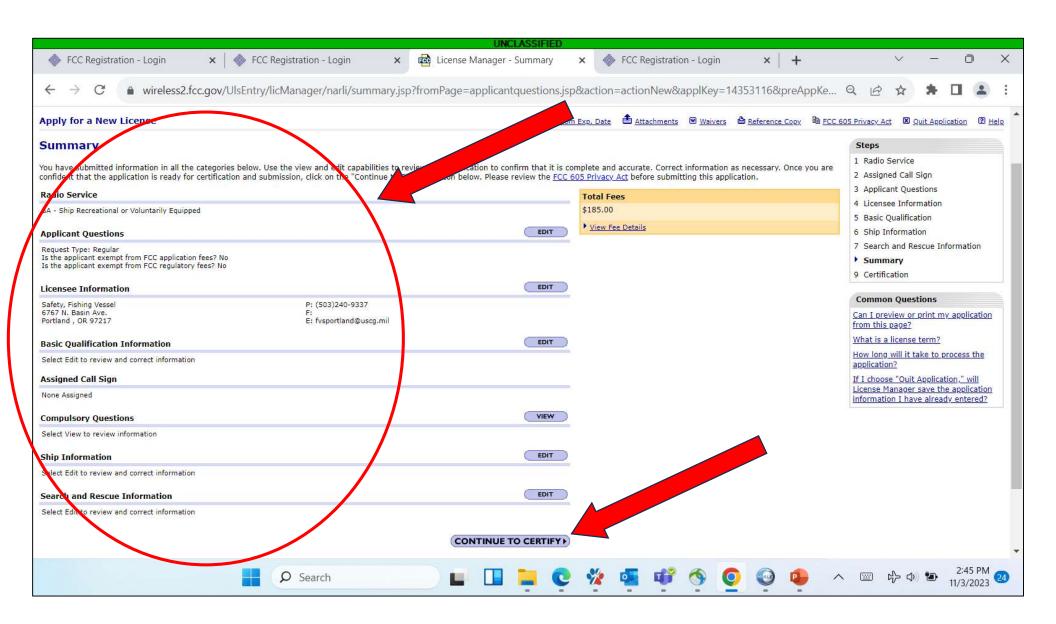
Enter the EPIRB identification code. Select the appropriate equipment onboard. All vessels select VHF; select MF or HF for sideband radios; select 406MHZ EPIRB if the vessel has an EPIRB; select DSC if your radio(s) have a red Distress/DSC button. Then select "Continue".



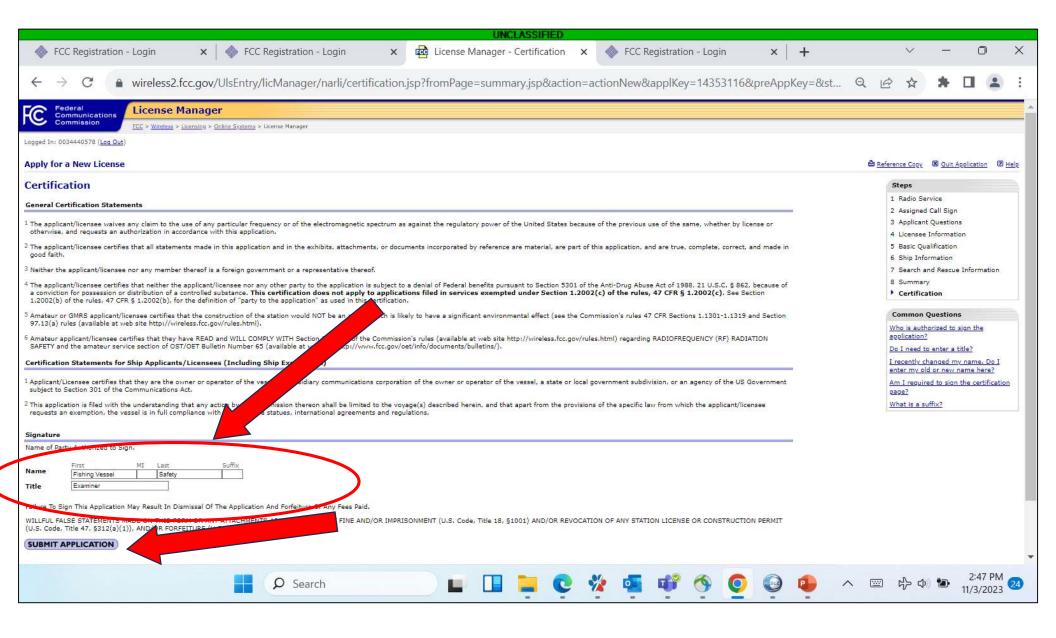
### Enter the crew size and number of liferafts on the vessel. Then select "Continue".



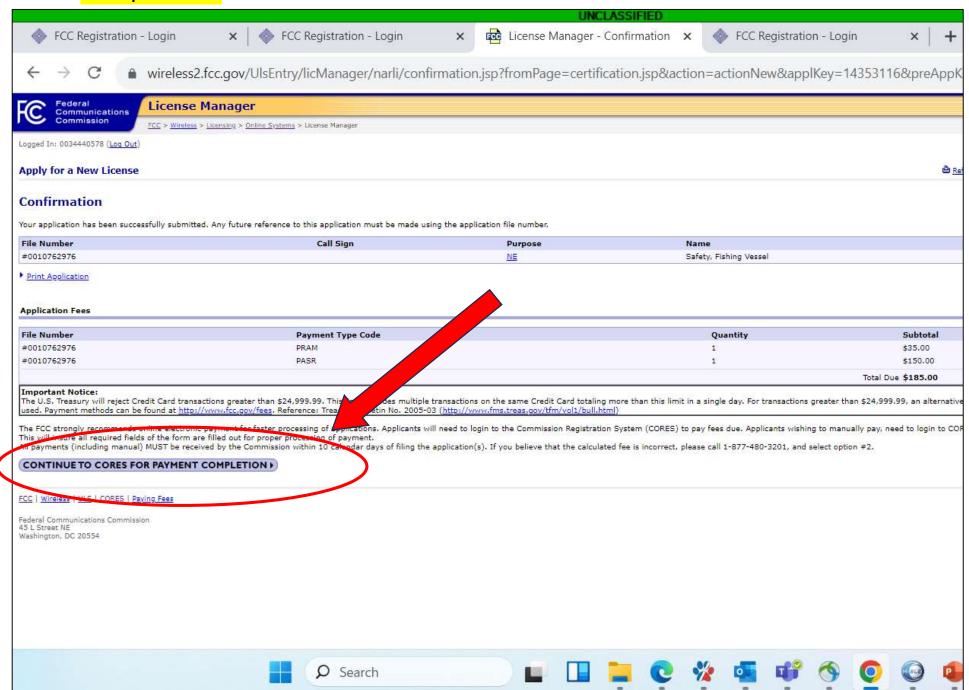
## Review the information and edit as necessary. Then select "Continue to Certify".



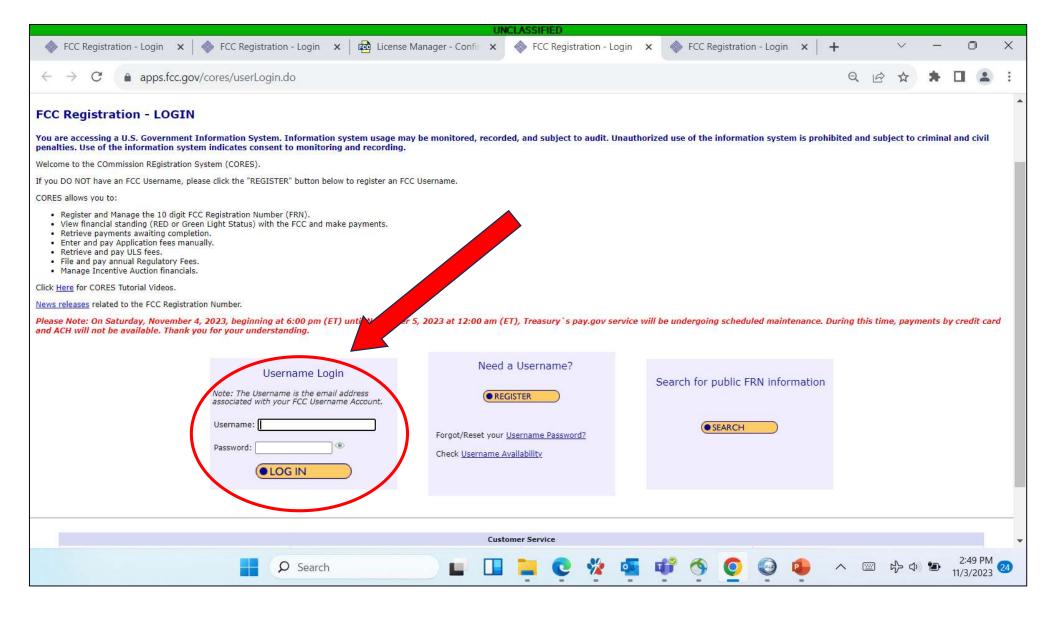
# Enter your name and title to certify the application. Then select "Submit Application".



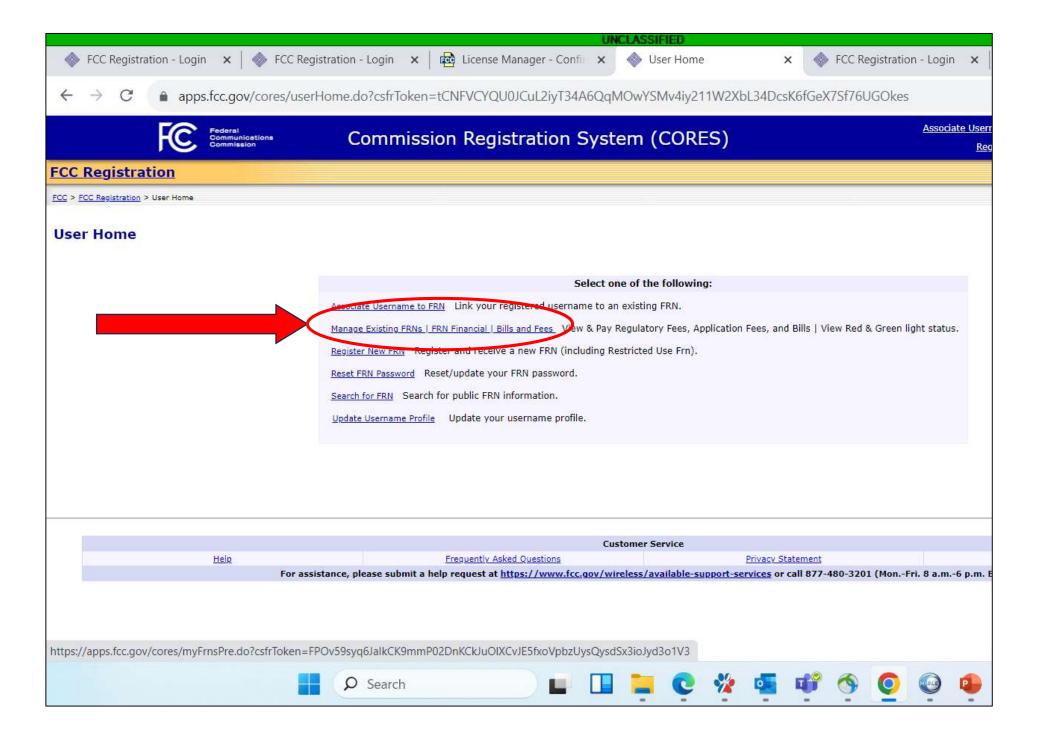
# Review the information. Then select "Continue to CORES for Payment Completion".



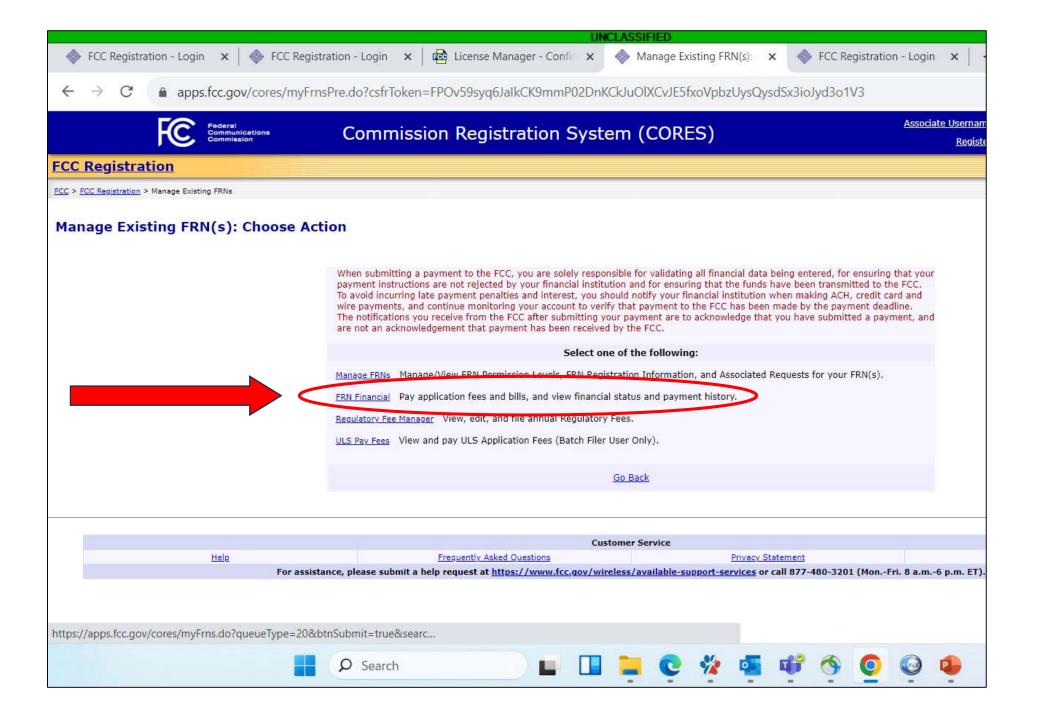

☐ In order to get the "SB" for "Ship Compulsory Equipped" License that is required for federally documented commercial fishing industry vessels, send an email to the FCC at <a href="https://example.com/Attach605@fcc.gov">Attach605@fcc.gov</a> .
☐ Include the FRN number in the subject line.
☐ Include the following text in the body of the email:
"My vessel is required to carry radio equipment under Coast Guard regulations and the required category is not listed on the FCC 605 Schedule B item 14 A-E."
***Send the email immediately after paying for the license. Once the email is received, they will adjust the license category on their end.
☐ If you have problems with payment processing, you may have to log out and log back in.
